A ripe, impactful flavour, balancing acidity with the flavour of stone fruits

- 21) **Rosso Piceno, Sangiovese 2019 Piersanti** £30
This is a firm, medium weight wine with richness and a plum finish

- 46) **Bardolino Chiaretto DOC 2020 - La Cavalchina** £36
Corvina and Rondinella grapes, juicy yet elegant pink with a snap of herbs

White Wines

TOSCANA

30) Pomino Bianco DOC 2020 - Frescobaldi £42
Unusual blend of Pinot Blanc and Chardonnay, lovely floral bouquet and lingering finish, excellent with lean fish based dishes

31) Vermentino Bolgheri DOC 2020 Guado Al Tasso - Antinori £55
100% Vermentino. This shows the combination of crispness and breadth that marks Vermentino, with engaging citrus flavours and a long mineral finish

PIEMONTE

32) Roero Arneis Le Madri DOC 2019 - Michele Chiarlo £46
Pleasantly full bouquet after-yellow plums, a little lime, banana. Soft opening with a pleasant sweet fruit, gooseberries, pineapple something pointing from elegant freshness, full to the final

33) Gavi di Gavi 2020 DOCG – La Smilla £45
A delicious, lively and gently aromatic nose is matched by a fuller, mineral and citrus flavour on the lengthy palate

34) Rossj-Bass Langhe 2018 – Gaja £160
A great example of Italian Chardonnay, it is brimming with citrus fruits and floral notes. The palate is medium-bodied with honey and almonds with slight spicy oaky notes. The crisp acidity and long finish help show this wine's true class.

ALTO ADIGE

35) Pinot Grigio 2019 - Giran £39
This elegant Pinot Grigio offers delicate, floral aromas and tropical fruits. Light and clean with ripe pineapple and peach flavours, notes of sweet spice and a bright crisp finish

36) Pinot Bianco (Weissburgunder) 2019 - Giran £52
A white wine showing a combination of ripeness and minerality that lifts it above the ordinary.

EMILIA ROMAGNA

37) Sauvignon Blanc Colli Piacentini DOC 2019 - Castelli del Duca £34
A firm and distinctly herbal nose is followed by a deliciously crisp and grassy finish. This Sauvignon is fresh, smooth and well-balanced

FRIULI

38) Friulano 2020 – Branko

£36

Tocai is an indigenous and, all too often, much under-rated variety. A delicious and intensely flavoured wine with a perfume of honeysuckle and tropical fruits and a long finish

UMBRIA

39) Bramito del Cervo Umbria IGT 2020 - Castello della Sala

£59

Pale golden in colour with gold reflexes. On the nose is fruity with clean varietals character, vanilla flavour and toasted almonds. On the palate is soft and well balanced with an excellent structure

40) Cervaro della Sala Umbria IGT 2019 – Antinori

£150

Intense fragrance with aromatic notes of citrus, pears, and acacia flowers, which blend with hints of vanilla to heighten the wine's complexity. It is full-flavored and well-structured, with sweet notes of butter and hazelnut, while simultaneously persistent and minerally

LAZIO

41) Frascati Superiore DOCG 2019, Casale Marchese

£39

Made with Malvasia grapes. Fresh fragrance of tropical fruit with floral and herbal nuances. Melon, almond, acacia flowers, apples and citrus with a hint of aromatic mint come to mind. Full bodied with a good structure and an intense taste that confirms the nose, it lingers in a soft and elegant finish.

42) Greco di Tufo 2020 - Feudi San Gregorio

£42

Magnum 1,5L Greco di Tufo 2014 - Feudi San Gregorio

£80

A rich and powerfully aromatic nose reminiscent of apricot, peach and tropical melon leads to a creamy palate, harmoniously balanced with a refreshing minerality

43) Falanghina 20120 - Feudi San Gregorio

£34

The nose and palate are intense and persistent with notes of delicate white flowers and stone fruits. A refreshing, well-balanced wine with a long, clean and zesty-lemon finish

44) Fiano di Avellino Pietramara DOCG 2018 - I Favati

£52

Very aromatic, salt air, tangy nose, grapefruit, unusual profile with depth, minerality, savory notes, short-medium fantastic with seafoo

SICILIA

45) Etna Bianco D.O.C. 2019 - Cottanera **£55**

Great body, with the right level of acidity, to give a fresh, long-lasting sensation. Various scents can be appreciated, ranging from fresh citrus fruits to slight vegetal aromas, including some mineral, flint-like notes which, once poured, give it a distinguished character

22) Fileno, grillo DOC, 2019- Canicatti **£48**

Grillo is a traditional Sicilian grape. A lovely, firm, ripe nose with tones of citrus and on the palate a rounded and depth followed by a nicely balanced finish

Rosé Wines

46) Bardolino Chiaretto DOC 2020 - La Cavalchina **£36**

Corvina and Rondinella grapes, grown on the south side of Lake Garda, juicy elegant pink with a snap of herbiness on the finish.

47) Scalabrone Rosato 2020 - Guado al Tasso Bolgheri **£54**

A distinguished rosé with a fresh, fruity nose dominated by raspberry aromas; well-balanced and elegant on the palate with a long finish of raspberry and rose.

23) Whispering Angel, Côtes de Provence, 2020 **£60**

Fresh aroma and notes of citrus and pink grapefruit are only bettered by its smooth and creamy feel on the palate. The flavour is complex, with layers of fruity flavours; testament to the Provence region it comes from.

Red Wines

TOSCANA

50) Chianti Colli Senesi 2018 – Tenuta Bichi Borghesi **£32**

A full flavoured wine with distinctly earthy tones. Quite rich on the nose, followed by substantial breadth on the palate and good length on the finish

51) Morellino di Scansano – Santa Maria DOCG 2017 ,Frescobaldi **£60**

Ripe plum with notes of violet. Warm in the mouth with hazelnut, coffee and ripe fruits

54) Nobile di Montepulciano Riserva 2016 - Carpineto **£64**

On the nose, intense and typical aromas of fruits with a delicate hint of vanilla. On the palate is structured and well-balanced

52) Nipozzano Chianti Rufina Riserva DOCG 2018, Frescobaldi **£56**

An enticing, rather pronounced ruby red. Its suite of fragrances exhibits considerable complexity, opening to dark fruit such as plum and blackcurrant, pungent spiciness of cinnamon and clove. Solidly built but not heavy with long-lingering finish

53) Badia a Passignano Chianti Classico 2016 – Antinori **£110**

100% Sangiovese. The nose offers a wide range of fruity aromas. The complex, elegant palate shows plenty of fruit alongside savoury flavours, finishing long and vibrant

55) Bramasole Cortona, 2017 - La Bracesca Antinori **£150**

100% Syrah. This benchmark Tuscan Syrah offer an intense fragrance, with subtle hints of vanilla blended with notes of mature fruit. It is well balanced and elegant in the mouth, with flavours of red fruit and white plum, and a soft, lingering finish

56) Brunello di Montalcino Pian Delle Vigne 2014 – Antinori **£145**

Complex, generous nose with ripe aromas of cherries and raspberries, light tobacco notes and hints of coffee and cocoa powder. Multi-layered structure with a nicely rounded texture and elegant fruit leading to a very long finish

57) Cont'Ugo, Tenuta Guado al Tasso, Antinori 2017, Guado al Tasso **£120**

100% Merlot. The nose shows intense notes of plums, cherries, and raspberries in addition to wild berry fruit and spices. The palate is distinguished by its roundness and breadth. A wine of great depth and accessibility, finish bursting with fruit

60) Tignanello Toscana IGT 2018 – Antinori **£200**

85% Sangiovese, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc

An intensive ruby red colour with purple highlights, shows at nose of great red fruit intensity and notes of vanilla, chocolate and leather. The balance between acidity and tannins is excellent, the finish and aftertaste are of a lovely length and persistence

61) Guado al Tasso Bolgheri Superiore 2014 - Ten. Guado al Tasso **£220**

Extraordinary intense ruby red in colour. Fruity, with hints of toast, coffee and dark chocolate. Finely structured and complex; balanced, with soft tannins and a lingering finish. Displays unmistakable varietal flavour while retaining strong regional character

62) Ornellaia, Bolgheri Sup. DOC 2014 - Ten. dell'Ornellaia **£450**

Deep ruby and a remarkably beguiling bouquet boast rich fruit and spices notes. The palate shows well-rounded, full, and generous with glossy tannins and a complete absence of any roughness. This vintage adroitly masks that richness behind an expansive, then concludes with a near-endless finish

63) Solaja Toscana IGT 2014 – Antinori **£400**

Smokey, ripe and richly textured, with a real diversity of flavor elements on the palate, including berries, mint, fennel and a floral component

64) Sassicaia Bolgheri DOC 2016 – Tenuta San Guido **£580**

Sassicaia is a wild, exotic beauty. Sumptuous and flamboyantly ripe, the 2016 captures all the personality of the year in spades. Super-ripe red cherry, pomegranate and spice notes all flesh out in this curvy, racy beauty from Tenuta San Guido

PIEMONTE

65) Barbera d'Alba DOC 2018 **£38**

Red ruby, cherry nose, soft and dry

66) Nebbiolo Occhetti DOC 2018 – Prunotto **£60**

This single-vineyard Nebbiolo offers an elegant nose with hints of raspberries and roses. On the palate, it is full and harmonious with a long, positive finish

67) Barolo Patres DOCG 2017 - San Silvestro **£60**

A stylish Barolo, with expressive aromas of dried fruit, roses and tar. The deep fruits are layered with minerality on the smooth and mouth-filling palate and sweet tannins weave through to a very long, elegant finish

68) Barolo Dagromis DOCG 2015 – Gaja **£170**

This full-bodied wine on the palate is characterized by enchanting fruity aromas, which are linked to notes of spices, licorice, herbs, rose flowers and balsamic elements

69) Barbera d'Asti Sup. La Court DOC 2015 - Michele Chiarlo **£122**

The La Court estate, thanks to its excellent soil is the jewel in this farm's crown. The wine is complex, delicate and has a fascinating bouquet, rich in notes of ripe fruit. The taste is ample, rich and subtle with fresh palate and fine, long finish

70) Barbaresco DOCG 2017 - Cascina Morassino **£90**

Lovely cherry flavours predominate with hints of chocolate and floral undertones. The tannin structure is fine but firm with the added complexity of spicy oak. Voluptuous fruit abounds in this incredible wine - background of darker fruit, with dark notes of tar and liquorice as well as lifted notes of rose and spicy oak

71) Barolo Essenze Riserva, DOCG 2010 – ViteColte **£140**

Loads of tobacco, earth and prune flavours and fleshy sliced fruit. Full bodied, with silky tannins that build on the palate and turn to the finest cashmere in texture. Long and caressing. This is one of the great wines of Piedmont

ALTO ADIGE

76) Pinot noir Patricia DOC 2018 – Girlan **£50**

A characteristic Pinot Noir nose of strawberries and fruit is followed by broad warmth of texture and grip on the palate with a lovely soft finish

VENETO

- 72) Valpolicella Classico DOC 2019 - Brigaldara** **£38**
Valpolicella as it should be. It has a ripe, raisin, middle weight palate and a dry herbal finish
- 73) Ripasso della Valpolicella Sup. DOC 2018 – Brigaldara** **£55**
This is what real Valpolicella is all about, a single vineyard wine made in the cellars of one of the region's best producers. A wine to confound the critics. Ripe nose, middleweight palate and a dry herbal finish
- 74) Amarone della Valpolicella Cavolo Nero DOCG 2015 - Brigaldara** **£90**
- 75) Magnum 1.5L Amarone della Valpolicella Classico DOC 2015** **£180**
Unique nose of sweet, pruney fruit, gingerbread, and warm earth. Soft, intense and mouth filling flavours of blackberries, choke cherries, and old barrels. Lots of body, some tannins remain but are relatively unobtrusive. Very long in the mouth

FRIULI

- 77) Merlot 2019– Forchir** **£32**
A chewy, layered style with hints of berry fruit and mocha. Medium bodied, pure and impressive for a Merlot
- 78) Refosco dal Peduncolo Rosso DOC 2019 – Forchir** **£35**
The Refosco grape is a native of Friuli and said to be of ancient origin and it is the dal Peduncolo (literally 'red stem') sub variety that is generally regarded as producing the best quality wine. A deliciously soft red with a crisp, vibrant bites on a good, long finish

CAMPANIA

- 80) Aglianico Trigaio 2018 - Feudi di San Gregorio** **£38**
100% Aglianico grapes, refined in barrique for 12 months. Ruby red in color, soft and warm to the palate, this wine is ideal with red meats, game and mature cheese

PUGLIA

- 81) Primitivo Tuma' 2019 – Masseria Cuturi** **£40**
A good intense nose with a fruit cake touch followed by a palate of breadth and texture and a good long finish

SICILIA

- 82) Nero d'Avola Centouno 2019 – Canicatti'** **£34**
A silky texture characterises the impact of this wine on the mouth, this follows a lovely rich fruitcake nose of some intensity

Red Wine

100) Barolo DOCG 2015 Paesi tuoi - Terredavino **£43**

Nebbiolo is a fickle grape famed as much for its pale appearance as for its tannic character and produces some of the most perfumed and richly flavored wines. Though generally only medium-bodied, the wines possess rose and anise scented aromatics and flavours of cherry, orange peel and subtle green herb tones.

101) Amarone della Valpolicella, Brigaldara - 2015 **£60**

Soft, intense and mouth filling flavours of blackberries, choke cherries, and old barrels. Lots of body, some tannins remain but are relatively unobtrusive. Very long in the mouth.

102) Nipozzano Chianti Rufina Riserva DOCG 2016- Frescobaldi **£30**

An enticing, rather pronounced ruby red. Its suite of fragrances exhibits considerable complexity, opening to dark fruit such as plum and blackcurrant, pungent spiciness of cinnamon and clove. Solidly-built but not heavy with long-lingering finish

103) Il Bruciato, Tenute Guado al Tasso, Halves, Antinori 2019 **£45**

Fragrant fruity aromas, particularly plum, followed by delicate mint and green tea notes. On the palate it is full-bodied and smooth with a long finish.

White Wine

48) Cervaro della Sala 2019 - Marchesi Antinori Umbria IGT **£80**

Intense, complex aroma with notes of white flowers and flint balanced by a hint of vanilla. Full-bodied and well-structured palate with notes of toast, citrus and mineral. Elegant and persistent in the mouth, this is a wine with a long life ahead of it.

49) Castel Firmian Pinot Grigio - Mezzacorona 2020 **£20**

100% Pinot Grigio Very clean, nicely balanced Pinot Grigio, with a gentle floral aroma, good medium weight in the mouth, and a refreshing

Made from 100% Vespaiola and aged in French oak, this wine is juicy and thick, with loads of orange-clover honey, apricot jam, and white flowers		
84) Malvasia Passito Colli Piacentini (375ml)	£12	£55
100% Malvasia Bianca di Candia aromatica A deliciously sweet wine with a lovely balancing crispness on the finish that makes it an ideal way to finish a meal		
85) Pomino Vin Santo, Frescobaldi (375ml)	£20	£80
Pomino Vinsanto is a golden colour, crystal-clear and brilliant. The nose is highly aromatic and fragrant: notes of honey and dried fruit are joined by spices such as nutmeg and cinnamon. On the palate it is smooth and fresh, with notes of toasted almonds and hazelnuts. The finish denotes a sweet component - excellent persistence		
86) Moscato D'Asti Nivole, Michele Chiarlo, (37.5cl)	N/A	£26
A rich, delicate and well-balanced dessert wine from the Muscat grape. Gently sparkling, the fruit dances lightly on the tongue
